Matthew 5: 13-16 "You are the salt of the earth; but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trodden under foot by men. "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hid. Nor do men light a lamp and put it under a bushel, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.



Have you ever been in a bad mood and was then with a group of people so positive and fun-loving that it was impossible to maintain that bad mood? Their words and laughter were so infectious that it sucked you in to their mindset no matter how hard you tried not to be. You were upset, and the reason was bonafide, and you had a right to be mad, and no one could take that away from you! First, there was a crack of a smile and when you realized it happened, you quickly stifled it. Then a little chuckle sneaked out and you closed your mouth so it wouldn't happen again. Pretty soon, a positive word or two found a crack to surface through and, well, the dam that was holding back the flood waters broke and you gave up that 'tude you had been sporting.

The opposite can also be true. You can be in a care-free, content frame of mind, and get into a situation where there is nothing but negativity with gloom and doom all around. You leave feeling that there is no hope and you might as well give up and crawl in a hole somewhere until it's all over. No doubt, there is a time and place for difficult discussions. But, even then, there is a way to go about it which is honoring to God and those present.

It is said that there is nothing new under the sun, and if we find ourselves in tough spots, all we have to do is open the Bible and see that this is still true. Paul, Job, Joseph, and many, many others give us examples of holding fast to our faith in the midst of problematic situations, and how to be what we are called to be in a fragmented world.

God calls us to be salt and light in the world. We are also called to live "in" the world, but not "of" it. Attitudes and how we go about things are not only seen & heard, but also felt by others — which in turn is passed along to yet others, whether we realize we are passing it on or not. There is an infectious component to how we conduct ourselves and live our lives. It bears careful examination of one's self to ask, "What am I spreading these days?" & "Am I purposefully trying to make a positive difference in my sphere of influence?"

Hope, faith, and positivity abounds - *look for it, be it, spread it* – in the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.






