## Gifts and Gifting

Having just finished giving and receiving the gifts typically given at Christmas time, we are mindful of the different attitudes that motivates one to give. Some give because that's just what is expected of us, an obligation of sorts. Some give to 'out-give' others and elevate self. Some give marking it off of the 'to do' list. Some give only out of their abundance, while others are giving sacrificially. Some lovingly gift others, and some begrudgingly give gifts. The list goes on.

There are just as many ways to receive gifts as there are to give them. You can show love and honor in gratefully receiving gifts, or be critical or disrespectful in the manner in which we treat the giver or gift. Do we act as if we deserve any and all gifts we get and lift up those who are able to give larger gifts than others? Or do we treat the givers and gifts with equal gratitude, showing value to both?

I'm sure that we can think of times that fit most of these situations, but all of this pales in importance when we look at the most unselfish, loving, and sacrificial giving we find in Jesus Christ. The song lyrics remind us: He came from Heaven to earth to show the way, from the earth to the cross my debt to pay, from the cross to the grave, from the grave to the sky - but it didn't stop there. The Holy Spirit was sent as a Helper with the same motivation—love. This makes everything else we placed value or importance on seem to evaporate. The shame of materialism over loving our triune God and our fellow man enters in and we find ourselves standing in the need of forgiveness.

It is so fitting that we enter into a new year choosing to do self examination and re-evaluation. The adjustments are aimed at consciously making an effort to do better or be better in some way. Let's be sure to not only look at the worldly aspects of living, but consider our spiritual health as well. Getting closer to God and using our spiritual gifts and talents takes determination and action as well.

How does this approaching new year find you? Could you make some adjustments to facilitate growth? Remember, this not only affects you, but encourages others as they witness your changes!





clever tyrant.







God bless this sweet family and let the action begin!!




