- The USDA Commodities needs a leader and Connie Grieve is looking for a person to do it.
- Pastor Don may need knee surgery.
- The undesignated giving for the month was \$7,485 which is \$2,326.08 short of the monthly budget. The beginning balance for December was -\$534.97 with a deposit going in the following Monday. Utilities were \$1,311.01 with \$152.90 paid for communion cups and \$108.99 for Microsoft 365 yearly program.
- The 2024 budget that the Board had approved needed amended. Insurance is going up \$2,000 from the 2023 amount. Motion to increase the insurance amount by another \$1,000 for a total of \$14,000 for the 2024 year was carried.
- The Elderetti Spaghetti Dinner is set for February 4, 2024.
- The elder committee is prayerfully considering some new Elders.
- CWF went to the public library December 6 & 7 to help with crafts during story hours. They will meet January 10th for their annual party.
- Still waiting on playground equipment to arrive and had to return a defective tire swing for a new one. We need some custodial supplies per custodian request.


