As I write this, I'm sitting on my back patio, the sun is shining, and the air is filled with the first signs of summer. It's hard to believe we're still in the midst of THE PANDEM-IC. Then again, nothing about the past few years has been believable.

We were not meant for isolation; we weren't created for it. God literally created us to be in relationship: with Him and with one another. So to be alone—physically away from many of the people with which we fill our lives—is hard. Don't get me wrong: I'm around people all the time. But we're still isolated from our families and friends and

church family—our community. I know many of us are already back to worshipping together at the church building, but where are the others? The ones who were here before all of this; the other smiling faces, singing together, shouting our praise to God, and greeting each one of you with a handshake or hug after the service?

I remember spending many, many hours talking with other pastors, hearing what other churches did, listening to webinars Clinic and CDC, as well as talking with a variety of people from other congregation. I remember discussions of what it would look like to worship in-person, 60-75 people with 6-foot distancing. Everyone would need to wear masks. To maximize the number of people able to attend, ushers would direct people to seats like hosts at restaurants. After worship, we would dismiss by rows to reduce congestion in the narthex. Worship wasn't going to look like it once did. We would simply come into the sanctuary for a very simplified service and then leave. I began asking myself some questions. Most importantly, isn't this what we are doing now? The official end of the COVID 19 pandemic was declared on May 5th, why are we still isolated? The answer was easy: because we all don't miss the community and connection that worshiping in-person brings.

Here's the deal: prayer can be public or private, but something happens when we touch and agree. Worship can be public or private, but where two or more are gathered. But praise must always be public. It is how we show the world how we feel about our God. Our old normal is not going to happen... at least not right now. So

why don't we gather in community in different ways? And that's really the crux of being Church during a pandemic: how can we re-envision what it looks like to be community?

I encourage you to take a look, and prayerfully discern how you can participate in our beloved community in new ways. We are still the Church; it just looks different than anything we've ever seen. And we are still a community, working together to understand what that means in this time and this place. I really do believe that this is an opportunity to open ourselves to the new things God wants to do among us and through us.

Thankfully, we are rooted in our strong foundation of Jesus Christ.
